1	O&M of Water Pumping Stations	January	22 - 26	The training course aims to train the operators how to operate and maintain water pumping stations, overcome common daily problems, and relevant health and safety measurements.
2	O&M of Sewage Networks	February	26 - 29	The training aims to enhance the skills of the technicians on the safe and effective practices in performing the operation and maintenance works that ensures their personal safety, the safety of equipment they are operating and the work environment.
3	Non Revenue Water Management Basic Course	March	25 - 29	This course aims at explaining the main components of NRW and identifies them in the water supply system as well as enhancing the capacity of the water utilities staff in designing and implementing NRW countermeasures.
4	O&M of Water Networks	April	22 - 27	The training aims to enhance the skills of the technicians on the safe and effective practices in performing the operation and maintenance works that ensures their personal safety, the safety of equipment they are operating and the work environment.
5	Non Revenue Water Management Level	May	27 - 31	This training course aims at enabling the participants to be familiar with the concepts and approaches of non revenue water management and reduction approaches of water utilities to enhance the financial and environmental sustainability. Also, this course aims at improving the planning and design of the water systems strategies and reducing the complaint response time.
6	GIS for Water Utilities Basic Course	June	24 - 28	This training course aims to introduce the water professionals to the geographic information system (GIS) as well as its application in planning, design and implementation in the water and wastewater sector.
7	O&M of Sewage Pumping Stations	August	26 - 30	The training course aims to train the operators how to operate and maintain sewage pumping station, Overcome common daily problems, and relevant health and safety measurements.
8	GIS for Water Utilities Advanced Course	September	23 - 27	This training course aims to develop and strength the GIS skills of the water professionals in planning, Design and implementation of water, wastewater and environmental projects.
9	O&M of Wastewater Treatment Plants	October	21 - 25	This course is designed to train the operators to safely and effectively operate and maintain wastewater Treatment plants.
